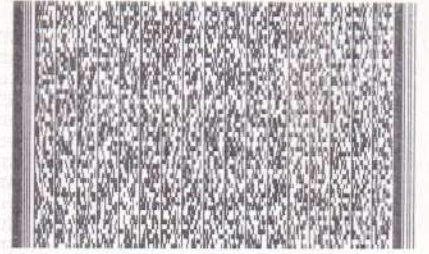

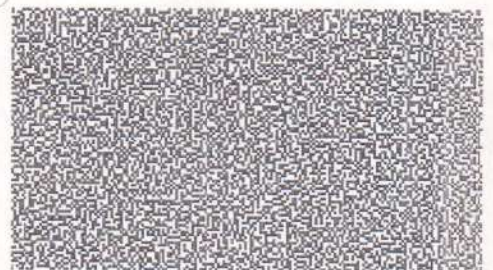

- 24 **PROPERTY:** All movable and immovable property of the organization will be in the name of the organization. The immovable property of the institution shall not be acquired or transferred by way of sale, donation or otherwise without the written permission of the Registrar, Firms and Institutions.
- 25 **CALLING OF THE MEETING BY THE REGISTRAR:** According to the registered rules of the organization, the registrar will have the right to call the meeting of firms and organizations if the office bearers do not call the annual meeting or if it is otherwise necessary. In addition, the subject for consideration in the meeting will be able to make sure.
- 26 **DISPUTES-** If any kind of dispute arises in the organization, the president will have the right to resolve it with the permission of the general body. 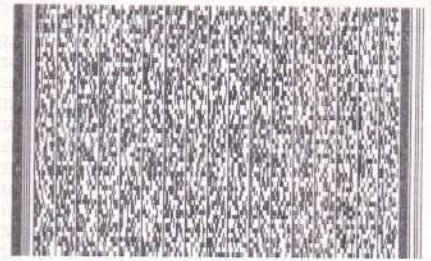
